This gathering follows on from the last Arise Bristol! Event in 2012 when thousands of Christians came together in repentance. This year will be quite different - a celebration of our diversity in unity with a worship service and stories of God's transforming grace in individuals and communities. This will be followed by a 'Party in the Park' with stalls, free food, family fun events and sporting activities to engage with the general public. There will be a focus on eight key spheres of society ranging across arts and media, business and workplace, education and young people, family, politics and social action, sport and health. In essence, Arising to the challenge of our great commission "To go and bring the Kingdom of God to the people".

TOGETHER FOR BRISTOL SPECTRUM: Going Deeper

Saturday 31th August ALL DAY.

This event will be a gathering to celebrate our work in Bristol and to explore more deeply issues of faith, practice and making a difference in society. As in previous SPECTRUM events, there will be stalls and exhibition stands profiling the diversity of Christian activity but there will also be a range of

seminars focussed on eight spheres of society building our understanding and of issues to improve how we work together to make an impact in our city. The day will culminate in a united service of celebration and music reflecting the rich diversity of worship from across the many traditions and cultures that make up our community.
