RELEASE ACADEMY

Release Academy is a 9 month, hands-on ministry training school run by LoveBristol Church. Based on the Bethel School of Supernatural Ministry, our primary aim is to equip students to be naturally supernatural everywhere they go irrespective of their background, vocation or age. This means learning to walk in the supernatural power of the Holy Spirit full of love, integrity, confidence, and honour.

Release Academy is designed to be a ministry training centre where our students embrace their true identity in Christ, learn the values of a Kingdom culture and walk in the authority and power of the King. It is an extremely fast-paced season of schooling but the training will equip students for a powerful and fruitful life and ministry.

DURATION // We have a full time and a part time course available. Our full time day school runs Tuesday - Friday from 10am - 4pm, and our part time evening course runs every Wednesday from 6-10pm. The course runs from September to May.

COURSE CONTENT // Content is taken primarily from Bethel's School of Supernatural Ministry (BSSM) in DVD format, with regular speakers including Bethel alumni and leaders from across the city. Lessons are supported by discussion and activation, book reviews and mentoring. Release Academy hold two retreat weekends away and a mission trip, and students are invited to participate in other trips throughout the year.

MULLERS PRACTICAL THEOLOGY TRAINING COURSE

Mullers Practical Theology Training Course has been running for over 20 years, and is an opportunity to cultivate deep theological roots, thereby developing more fruitful lives.

DURATION // One day a week (Tuesdays, 9.15-4pm) from September - June.

COURSE CONTENT // The course comprises twelve modules, and throughout the course we seek to encounter Jesus, examine the Bible, explore Theology, evaluate presuppositions and engage with culture. We try to maintain an academic rigour while being interactive and participative in teaching style. There is also the opportunity to receive an accreditation certificate in Practical Theology at Level 3. The course is free, and open to all, regardless of their prior educational achievement.


WTC courses are designed to equip the whole people of God for life, work, and mission in the real world. Our classes provide you with foundations in Scripture, spiritual life, Christian beliefs, church history, personal formation, mission, and leadership, and always with a concern for the gritty and complex realities of the real world.

DURATION // There are twenty teaching evenings, between 6pm and 10pm throughout the year. The courses are assessed by the submission of six essays throughout the year. There are two residential teaching blocks per year where all WTC students, from across Europe, gather together. Courses can take 2+ years to complete.

COURSE CONTENT // The courses on offer at the Bristol Hub are the CertHE in Kingdom Theology, the BA in Kingdom Theology, the Graduate Diploma in Kingdom Theology and the MA in Kingdom Theology.

TRINITY SCHOOL OF THEOLOGY


Trinity College is a theological college in Bristol offering a range of full-time and part-time undergraduate and postgraduate courses. Our part-time students enrol with us because they're keen to go deeper with their faith and to understand more about God's Word and how it affects and directs everyday life. If you live in the Bristol area and want to engage in theological study alongside your current work, church, or family commitments, consider joining us part time. All of our undergraduate programmes are validated by the University of Durham, and postgraduate programmes are validated by the University of Aberdeen.

DURATION // The main teaching sessions for our part-time programme are held on Tuesday evenings, with an option to share supper in the dining hall and join in a short worship service with fellow students before evening classes begin. Courses can take between one - six years to complete on a part time basis.

COURSE CONTENT // Our part time programmes include: The Foundation Award - Certificate in Theology, Ministry and Mission, Diploma - BA - Graduate Diploma - Postgraduate Diploma - MA

DURATION // The course starts mid-September and will finish in July. You will also serve at United conference in the summer.

COURSE CONTENT // The Course is structured into theological teaching and training, and practical placements through a local church based on your passions and giftings. Theological Training & Teaching [Tuesday]: The theological teaching is delivered through the Müller Trust Foundation, training and equipping you to grow as a disciple of Jesus. Internships [15-30hours p/w]: You'll be serving as part of a local Church, putting into practice all you are learning whilst being mentored, coached and invested in by local Church leaders.

THE BRISTOL PROPHETIC MENTORING SCHOOL

Bristol Prophetic Mentoring School is run by Liz Evans and her team at Love has a Voice. They are passionate about seeing each person enjoying and released in their gift to serve God.

Liz has been in Church and Prophetic leadership for 15 years, running prophetic outreach communities training churches and supporting leaders with prophetic ministry in Europe. See lovehasavoice.org

This school gives prophetic people a safe place to train their gift, find out how they personally are made to serve God and how they can function in their own unique church context and to impact the world around them. The course offers training the mature prophetic skills of hearing and seeing revelation, sound mature interpretation and

application using wise protocol to bring transformation; with a Christlike spirit and sense of humility and humour.

DURATION // Three Saturdays a term 10am-4pm.
There is a one year course with optional second year.
Followed by the new Graduate School for those who want to stay engaged in the prophetic learning, supportive community.

COURSE CONTENT // Biblical teaching, real life wisdom for gifted people in a friendly pastoral community and practical skills workshops, worship and focussed time with God.
