<u>Guests:</u> BCS has been running for 1 month, having opened on 2nd October, and has so far been able to welcome 10 guests into the safety of the guesthouse. One guest has already moved into secure accommodation and three guests have been referred for rooms in supported housing run by churches in Bristol (Hope into Action). Several guests are attending regular viewings for private rental properties but it's very competitive for accommodation in Bristol so it's proving difficult. A team from the council gave the guests laptops so they could improve their chances of searching and finding properties. Please pray that God will provide a way for them!

<u>Winter 23/24:</u> This winter, BCS has block booked a centrally located guesthouse from the beginning of Oct 2023 to the end of March 2024 to accommodate guests with low support needs. BCS has been recognised by Bristol City Council for its integral and effective role in reducing rough sleeping in the city. They awarded funding for 6 months to cover the significant costs of the guesthouse this winter. This does not however cover the full costs of providing the shelter. This church project **remains in need of approximately £5,000** to cover the costs of this year's shelter.
